INTRODUCE baby sign

TEACH YOUR CHILD TO COMMUNICATE IN A VARIETY OF WAYS USING GESTURES AND SIMPLE SIGNS.



GETTING BASIC NEEDS MET

Teach your child the signs for "eat" and "drink" (or "milk").



ASKING FOR MORE

Teach your child the sign for "more"



ASKING QUESTIONS

Teach your child to put their hands palm up and out to the side to ask "Where?" and "What's that?"



SOCIAL ROUTINES

Teach your child to wave hi/bye, blow kisses for "I love you", and say "my turn" during play.



PROTESTING

Teach your child to sign "all done" to finish, sign"stop", or shake their head no to refuse something.



COMMENTING

Teach your child to point to show or bring a finger to their ear when they hear something



REQUESTING

Teach your child to point to items they want or use the sign for "want" or "please"



ASKING FOR HELP

Teach child the sign for "help".



ANSWERING YES/NO

No need for sign language! A simple head nod/shake will do!
