"UP", "I WANT UP", "PICK ME UP", OR "UP MOMMY"

3. PULLING YOUR HAND TO BRING YOU SOMEWHERE



"COME ON", "LET'S GO MOMMY", "FOLLOW ME", OR "COME OVER HERE"

4. BRINGING YOU A TOY THAT REQUIRES HELP



"HELP", "HELP ME", "OPEN IT PLEASE", OR "I NEED HELP"

5. DIVING TOWARD THE FLOOR TO GET DOWN



"DOWN", "GET DOWN", "I WANT DOWN MOMMY", OR "WALK PLEASE"
